



After flooding impacted the Hewlett Packard Enterprise Houston campus multiple times, it was time for a move. REES programmed, planned and provided early conceptual design for the campus' core and shell. Working closely with the developer, REES represented HPE through the development process. As HPE's architect, REES designed the interior office space, technical product development, data center, headquarters functions and amenity spaces. The 446,000-square-foot facility in City Place offers a variety of workspaces to improve employee productivity and support an "edge to office" flexible work environment. A spectacular, threestory lobby links the project's two towers and provides views of the exterior courtyard. The customer experience center includes sophisticated conference space, an immersive theater and outdoor dining terrace. The new campus brings world class amenities, vibrant design elements, inclusive work areas and state of the art product development capabilities to an inspiring new location.




Corporate Office Consolidation

Hewlett Packard Enterprise Roseville, California

Wanting to update an aging building, Hewlett Packard Enterprise looked to REES to help consolidate part of its sales team onto a single floor. Using repurposed furniture and knocking down several walls, REES retrofitted an outdated and confined workspace to modernize the space, support a variety of work styles and encourage collaboration. Carefully curated furniture nooks, noise-cancelling focus pods and private conference rooms accommodate different work styles. Dispersed along the periphery of the assigned workstations, noise-cancelling focus pods provide employees a place for private conversations and phone calls. The employee lounge and breakroom offers a modern space conducive to both private conversations and informal group gatherings.
















Innovation Lab, Office and Training Floor Consolidation

Hewlett Packard Enterprise needed to relocate several of its workspaces. The 68,000-square-foot renovation consolidated onto one floor plate an innovation lab, training facility, 140 employee workstations, conference space, collaborative work rooms, employees lounges and a new customer engagement center. Hewlett Packard Enterprise wanted the design to be industrial, modern and welcoming. The exposed ceilings, innovative light fixtures and concrete-inspired floors provide an industrial warehouse look while wood accents are warm and inviting. Repurposed furniture and an overstock of carpet from a previous project were incorporated and used through out the space.


Goosehead Insurance




Goosehead Insurance

The social hub of the office, the game room, is partitioned by a dynamic wall featuring geometric tiles that can be flipped manually. Vibrant colors, textured fabrics and bold patterns add a youthful energy to the space.










Corporate Office Interior Fit-Out

Goosehead Insurance needed to expand the sales department at their San Antonio office due to the rapid growth. The new 22,000-square-foot-space includes Directors Offices, one-on-one rooms, large and medium conference rooms, a cafe, mother's room, IT/server room, storage spaces, mail room, reception, copy stations and 150 plus benching workstations. Wall art draws inspiration from local monuments, giving an artistic ode to the San Antonio River Walk.



Furniture selections aimed to blend residential comfort with a commercial edge to create a hospitable and modern atmosphere. A branded wall fixture in the open lobby stretches through both floors, making an instant impression on guests.



With the move, HoganTaylor also asked REES to help transition to a more open and collaborative office environment. After a series of test fits, our designers created the right mix of open and private offices for their team. A variety of focus, team and conference rooms give flexibility for meetings of all sizes. The design balances residential and commercial elements to create a relaxed environment. The balcony serves as an additional breakout space allowing employees and clients enjoy the vibrancy of downtown Oklahoma City.











Corporate Office Consolidation

Hewlett Packard Enterprise

Plano, Texas

Hewlett Packard Enterprise needed to consolidate its sales team onto a single floor plate. REES retrofitted an underutilized floor to increase capacity, accommodate different work styles and encourage collaboration. Gamification technology was added to the perimeter of the core sales room allowing the sales team to track live sales calls in real time. Dispersed throughout the floor are noise-canceling focus pods allowing employees a place for private conversations and phone calls. Three unused training rooms were re-imagined into subdivided, bench-style office neighborhoods offering nooks for breakout meetings and impromptu collaborations. Several other areas were repurposed into breakout conference rooms featuring textured and brightly-colored felt wall coverings. Vibrant furniture, modern textiles and patterned carpeting helps energize the space.









Office Floor Renovation

Hewlett Packard Enterprise *Alpharetta, Georgia*

Hewlett Packard Enterprise sought to repurpose a full floor at their Alpharetta campus to increase productivity and better utilize their space. REES responded with a design that provides neighborhood centers for specific departments to ease cross-functional collaboration. The layout is specialized for mobile workers without dedicated desk spaces. It provides 150 more seats than requested. It's also tech-friendly with various electrical and data capabilities including pop-up outlets on tables. The plan also added a single traditional conference room for formal meetings.

In order to consolidate multiple offices, Micro Focus needed space for 270 employees. REES designed a 28,300-square-foot open office to promote flexibility and collaboration. Decorative film coats glass-enclosed rooms allowing light to enter without sacrificing privacy. A tech-friendly neighborhood center along with focus and team rooms promote cross-functional collaboration and team activities. A variety of desking styles, including sit-stand desks in the free address space help prevent repetitive layouts. REES' efficient design provided 50 additional workspaces than the client requested, perfect for future growth.



Much like a proofreader for a written document, this person ensures that our documents meet our high-quality standards.

Quality Improvement is how we take lessons learned and apply them to future projects. At the end of each project our team reviews our work and identifies any areas for improvement on future projects. We then share these opportunities with the rest of the team so all of our clients benefit from our continual improvement.

Your Principal-In-Charge will check in on a monthly basis to determine your overall satisfaction. This keeps the lines of communication open and gives you a built-in opportunity to tell us how we can better meet your needs.

We will follow up with you 90 days after occupancy to make sure your project is performing as planned.
